Mark Your Calendars

The 2024 Giving Challenge will happen from noon to noon, April 9-10. Keep track of these key dates in early 2024 as the 24-hour online giving day approaches.

5:00 PM, January 12	Deadline for EXISTING & NEW profiles in The Giving Partner to be submitted for re-verification & review to be eligible to participate in the 2024 Giving Challenge.
5:00 PM, January 12	Deadline for ALL nonprofit organizations to register for the 2024 Giving Challenge.
February 1, 2024	Pre-Giving Challenge prize applications open.
5:00 PM, March 5	Deadline to submit <u>Pre</u> -Giving Challenge prize applications.
