Capacity Building Grants

Capacity Building grants help improve a nonprofit's ability to fulfill its mission by strengthening its capacity. Capacity strengthening areas include data gathering, evaluation, learning, assessment, planning, fundraising, leadership, and emergency needs.

The application deadline for our first grant cycle is August 30, 2024. Future grant cycles for the current fiscal year open on the following dates:


- September 16, 2024
- November 1, 2024

Animal Welfare Grants

Animal Welfare grants (up to \$25,000) support organizations that serve animals and promote their humane care. Funding priorities will focus on emergency veterinary treatment for urgent cases or extraordinary medical needs and large equipment purchases, such as X-ray machines, for a clinic.

The application will open on December 13, 2024, and close on January 10, 2024.

Parent Leadership Grants encourage a commitment to ensuring the parent perspective and expertise to inform program and organization development. This might look like creating a Parent Advisory Council, adding a parent to the Board of Directors, or offering leadership development workshops to caregivers.

The grant application cycle will open on February 25, 2025.

Through a collaboration with the Indiana University Indianapolis Lilly Family School of Philanthropy, The Patterson Foundation's Nonprofit Internship Program connects students at the school with opportunities at nonprofits in the Suncoast region.
