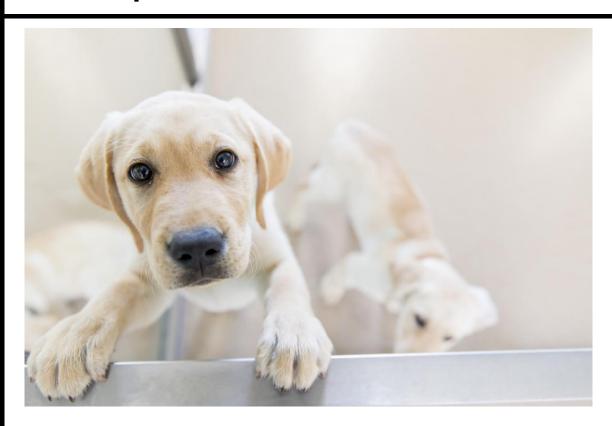

Now Accepting Applications for Animal Welfare Grants

The deadline to apply is Sunday, Dec. 14.

Our new Animal Welfare grant cycle **has begun!** The program focuses on supporting organizations in the animal welfare sector in the following ways:

- Funding emergency veterinary treatments for urgent cases or extraordinary medical needs
- Supporting the purchase of large equipment, such as X-ray machines

Applications are due by midnight on Sunday, Dec. 14, 2025.

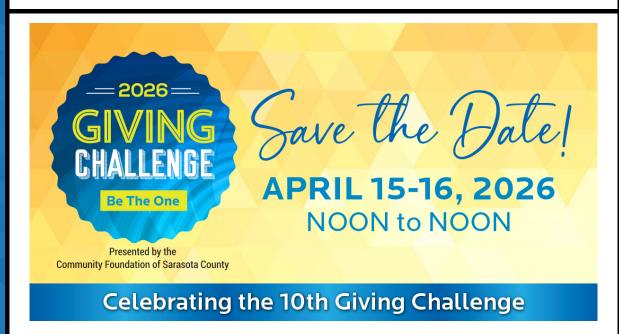

How to Get Your Nonprofit Ready to Participate in the 2026 Giving Challenge

Step #1: Make Sure Your Giving Partner Profile Is Updated

Nonprofits that want to participate in next year's Giving Challenge must first ensure that their Giving Partner profile is current.

A key requirement to participate in the 2026 Giving Challenge is for nonprofits to have a complete, accurate, and updated profile in <u>The Giving Partner</u>. Nonprofits with an existing Giving Partner profile must ensure that <u>all</u> updates are made by **noon on Wednesday**, **Dec. 31**, **2025**.

If you're not sure what that entails, <u>this handy checklist</u> includes all the details and documentation you will need to update your profile. Don't let your nonprofit miss out on the chance to participate in next year's challenge!

Step #2: Register for the Giving Challenge

After your Giving Partner profile is set, don't forget to officially sign up for the 2026 Giving Challenge.

In addition to updating your Giving Partner profile, you must also officially register with the Giving Challenge at <u>GivingChallenge.org</u>. The deadline to register is **noon on Wednesday**, **Dec. 31**, **2025**.

Note: This deadline is <u>significantly earlier</u> than for past Giving Challenges. If your registration is not complete by the deadline, you will **not be eligible** to participate in the 2026 Giving Challenge.
