Last month, we shared an opportunity to learn more about Give 8/28, a national charitable giving day dedicated to inspiring philanthropy by and for Black communities. Since then, several local nonprofit organizations have registered to participate in this third annual give day on August 28, 2020.

As a way to encourage local involvement, the Community Foundation of Sarasota County awarded \$250 grants to the first 20 nonprofit organizations who registered to participate within Sarasota, Manatee, Charlotte, and DeSoto counties. More than ten organizations voiced their interest to join the give day hosted by the Young, Black and Giving Back (YBGB) Institute, which has been offered since 2018.
