Now Available on Giving Challenge & The Giving Partner Websites

The Giving Challenge and The Giving Partner websites now provide an inclusive online experience for visitors through **Recite Me** assistive technology.

By clicking on the accessibility circle icon (pictured to the left), visitors on your profile page (and beyond) can access the Recite Me toolbar with a wide range of accessibility and language support tools to customize their digital experience, including:



- Screen reader functionality
- Multiple reading aids – ruler, magnifier, dictionary, and more
- Customizable styling and resizing options – text size, color, font, and more
- On-demand translation into more than 100 languages, including 35 text-to-speech options
